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My Body Given for You - Helmut Hoping 2019

The Eucharist originated at the Last Supper of Jesus with his disciples. It is based on the prayer of thanksgiving that Jesus pronounced over the bread and wine at that meal. "Eucharist" means "thanksgiving", "praise", and "blessing". The Church celebrates the Eucharist as a memorial of the death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, which is more than a remembrance of the Last Supper of Jesus with his disciples. In the Eucharist the sacrifice of our redemption becomes present sacramentally. In the past, dogmatic theology has treated the meaning of the Eucharist while disregarding the form of its liturgical celebration, whereas liturgical studies have been content with only the latter. Yet the two cannot be separated, any more than liturgy and dogma or pastoral practice and doctrine can be understood without the other. The Church's liturgy is not something external to Christian revelation, but rather, as Joseph Ratzinger said, "revelation accepted in faith and prayer". In this work Helmut Hoping combines the approaches of dogmatic theology and liturgy while examining the Eucharist from a historical and systematic perspective. This new English translation of the second German edition of this major work, revised and expanded, includes a comparative analysis of the Second Eucharistic Prayer and a chapter on the theology of the words of institution.

They arise from the conviction that only the Scriptures of the New Covenant, taken as witnesses of faith and in their entirety, can produce a tangible and credible portrait of Jesus Christ, whereas every critical attempt to approach him from a position other than that of the faith witnessed to in the Scriptures can only result in a pallid, distorted picture unworthy of belief (and hence devoid of interest). And only the person who is confident of knowing him as he is, can know that he is also known by him.

The detailed description of the Jerusalemite liturgy, especially for the feasts of the liturgical year, offers us a vivid picture of Jerusalem's unique role in Christian devotion and the mysterious connection between the Christian

faith and the land of biblical history. The presentation of the anaphora of St. James will enlighten our understanding of the Eucharistic prayer in all the liturgical traditions, especially Syriac, Byzantine and Roman.

Benoît XVI - Philippe Levillain 2008

Le 19 avril 2005, le cardinal Ratzinger, préfet de la Congrégation pour la Doctrine de la foi depuis 1982 et âgé de 77 ans, était élu à la chaire de Saint-Pierre après un conclave rapide. A Jean-Paul II, dont le pontificat avait été scandé de bruits alarmistes et de conjectures parfois arbitraires, succédait un théologien à la réputation intellectuelle grevée par l'image d'un curialiste doctrinaire, intransigeant et réactionnaire. Benoît XVI, dernier pape acteur de Vatican II (1962-1965), entré dans l'Histoire entre le deuil de la mémoire de Jean-Paul II, personnalité élevée au rang de star, et le scepticisme sur l'avenir de l'Église romaine. De la mort de Jean-Paul II, avec le rappel des grands traits de la figure du Slave romanisé en passant par un conclave où le futur Benoît XVI était donné élu, l'ouvrage présente la chronique d'une succession médiatisée.
