Per arricchirsi con le terre nel governatorato di N. ha infatti bisogno di avere, almeno sulla carta, un certo numero di contadini, ed è per questo che escogita il trucco delle anime morte. Lasciato il suo lavoro da impiegato, si aggira per le campagne rovinare da carestia e colera a comperare a poco prezzo i contadini morti dopo l'ultimo censimento che quindi risultano vivi per le istituzioni e per i quali vengono ancora pagate le tasse. Diventa così proprietario di moltissimi servi, che sono un grosso capitale da ipotecare, grazie alla disponibilità di piccoli e grandi proprietari terrieri o di quei notabili cittadini che incontra sul suo cammino, molti dei quali restano immortali assieme a lui come indimenticabili figure della letteratura. Questo romanzo, concepito sul modello della Commedia dantesca come un grande poema sulla Russia, ha una prima parte, pubblicata, che mescolando rappresentazione realistica e registro grottesco svela i difetti e i vizi del popolo russo, una seconda, edita in maniera incompleta, che mostra una possibile redenzione, e una terza parte, distrutta da Gogol, che avrebbe dovuto esaltare i valori spirituali, e le doti e le ricchezze morali dei connazionali. The Novel as Investigation - JoAnn Cannon 2006-01-01

Detective fiction is a universally popular genre; stories about the investigation of a crime by a detective are published all over the world and in hundreds of languages. Detective fiction provides more than entertainment, however; it often has a great deal to say about crime and punishment, justice and injustice, testimony and judgment. The Novel as Investigation examines a group of detective novels by three important Italian writers - Leonardo Sciascia, Dacia Maraini, and Antonio Tabucchi - whose conviction about the ethical responsibility of the writer manifests itself in their investigative fiction. Jo-Ann Cannon explores each writer's denunciation of societal ills in two complementary texts. These investigative novels shed light on pressing social ills, which are not particular to Italian society of the late twentieth century but are universal in scope: Sciascia focuses on abuses of power and the death penalty, Maraini on violence against women, Tabucchi on torture and police brutality. In addition, each of these texts self-reflexively explore the role of writing in society. Sciascia, Maraini, and Tabucchi all use their fiction to defend the power of the pen to address "il male del mondo." The Novel as Investigation will be of interest to a broad audience of readers, including those interested in Italian and comparative literature, Italian social history, and cultural studies.

Possessed - Rebecca R. Falkoff 2021-05-15

In *Possessed*, Rebecca R. Falkoff asks how hoarding—once a paradigm of economic rationality—came to be defined as a mental illness. Hoarding is unique among the disorders included in the American Psychiatric Association's DSM-5, because its diagnosis requires the existence of a material entity: the hoard. *Possessed* therefore considers the hoard as an aesthetic object produced by clashing perspectives about the meaning or value of objects. The 2000s have seen a surge of cultural interest in hoarding and those whose possessions overwhelm their living spaces. Unlike traditional economic elaborations of hoarding, which focus on stockpiles of bullion or grain, contemporary hoarding results in accumulations of objects that have little or no value or utility. Analyzing themes and structures of hoarding across a range of literary and visual texts—including works by Nikolai Gogol, Arthur Conan Doyle, Carlo Emilio Gadda, Luigi Malerba, Song Dong and E. L. Doctorow—Falkoff traces the fraught materialities of the present to cluttered spaces of modernity: bibliomaniacs' libraries, flea markets, crime scenes, dust-heaps, and digital archives. *Possessed* shows how the figure of the hoarder has come to personify the economic, epistemological, and ecological conditions of modernity. Thanks to generous funding from New York University and its participation in TOME (Toward an Open Monograph Ecosystem), the ebook editions of this book are available as Open Access (OA) volumes from Cornell Open (cornellopen.org) and other Open Access repositories.

In una cittadina della Russia ottocentesca, persa nella sterminata distesa della pianura sarmatica, l'arrivo di Čičikov turba la vita tranquilla e abitudinaria della gente del luogo. Personaggio bizzarro, Čičikov persegue un progetto furbo, macabro e disonesto: acquistare dai possidenti locali le "anime morte" - i nomi dei servi deceduti o scomparsi, ma non ancora cancellati dai registri amministrativi - per ottenere, sulla base del numero di uomini posseduti, terre e prestiti dallo Stato. Per il proprio piano - la cui idea fu suggerita a Gogol' da fatti di cronaca del tempo - il protagonista incontra personaggi "scopiti" dallo stile realista dello scrittore, e rappresentativi di un'umanità inerte, corrotta, "morta" anch'essa, perché pietrificata attorno a vizi capitali come l'avarizia. Pensato come un poema in prosa, a rappresentare la corruzione, ma anche, nella seconda e terza parte, il riscatto del genere umano attraverso la redenzione del protagonista, *Le anime morte* rimase incompiuto. Il primo libro, completo, e considerato un capolavoro della letteratura occidentale.

The Road to Parnassus: Artist Strategies in Contemporary Art - Diego Mantoan 2020-10-06

How can one become a successful artist? Where should one start a career in the art world? What are useful strategies to achieve recognition in the art system? Such questions hoard in students' minds ever since entering art school and they probably chase every kind of art professional who is at an early career stage. "The Road to Parnassus" tries to understand what makes a good start in today's art world, who are influential players in the field and which strategies might apply. The swift career ascension of Glasgow artist Douglas Gordon - one of today's leading visual artists - and of the broader YBA generation that rose into worldwide prominence in the 1990s - Damien Hirst and Sarah Lucas among the best known - serves as a convenient case to analyse contemporary artist strategies. This book takes a multidisciplinary approach - spanning from traditional art history, to sociology and economics - pursuing the reconstruction of the field of forces in art as intended by French sociologist Pierre Bourdieu. Compared to previous publications on art system dynamics, such as Thompson's "The \$12 Million Stuffed Shark", this book offers an enhanced understanding of the factors that allow a young artist to enter the arena of contemporary art. The present research should help uncover the art system logic - which appears enigmatic to non-experts - revealing that artists are aware they need to consider global trends, beat competitors and meet the demands of dealers, collectors, curators and museums. This book furthers existing contributions on the YBAs (for example Stallabrass' "High Art Lite"), offering innovative conclusions on recent British art, such as on the duality between London and Glasgow, the gender opposition among emerging artists and the predominance of resourceful authors.

The Italian Academies 1525-1700 - Jane E. Everson 2016-04-14

The intellectual societies known as Academies played a vital role in the development of culture, and scholarly debate throughout Italy between 1525-1700. They were fundamental in establishing the intellectual networks later defined as the 'République des Lettres', and in the dissemination of ideas in early modern Europe, through print, manuscript, oral debate and performance. This volume surveys the social and cultural role of Academies, challenging received ideas and incorporating recent archival findings on individuals, networks and texts. Ranging over Academies in both major and smaller or peripheral centres, these collected studies explore the interrelationships of Academies with other cultural forums. Individual essays examine the fluid nature of academies and their changing relationships to the political authorities; their role in the promotion of literature, the visual arts and theatre; and the diverse membership recorded for many academies, which included scientists, writers, printers, artists, political and religious thinkers, and, unusually, a number of talented women. Contributions by established international scholars together with studies by younger scholars active in this developing field of research map out new perspectives on the dynamic place of the Academies in early modern Italy. The publication results from the research collaboration 'The Italian Academies 1525-1700: the first intellectual networks of early modern Europe' funded by the Arts and Humanities Research Council and is edited by the senior investigators.
