Storia dei nonni che non ho avuto - Ivan Jablonka 2013-03-19

"Mi sono messo, da storico quale sono, sulle tracce dei nonni che non ho avuto. La loro vita finisce ben prima che cominci la mia: Matès e Idesa Jablonka sono miei parenti e al contempo sono perfetti estranei. Non sono famosi. Sono stati travolti dalle tragedie del XX secolo: lo stalinismo, la Seconda guerra mondiale, la distruzione dell'ebraismo europeo." Ivan Jablonka è uno studioso francese. Nipote di Matès Jablonka e Idesa Feder, non ha mai conosciuto i suoi nonni, assassinati ad Auschwitz. La famiglia ha origini polacche, più precisamente nel borgo di Parczew, non lontano da Lublino. È qui che Matès, "rivoluzionario di

professione", muove i primi passi come attivista nel Partito comunista e per questo finisce più volte in carcere. Nella lotta conosce Idesa, la più bella ragazza dello shtetl, anche lei iscritta al partito; si innamorano, si sposano e cercano riparo a Parigi come rifugiati politici, sul finire degli anni Trenta. Ma sarà proprio a Parigi che verranno arrestati, questa volta dalla polizia francese, perché ebrei, e in seguito deportati. La mattina dell'arresto, il 25 febbraio 1943, riescono a mettere in salvo i due figli, Marcel, papà di Ivan, e Suzanne, ai quali lasciano poche righe prima della partenza verso il lager: "Vi scriviamo questa cartolina come un addio in modo che abbiate un ricordo di noi, perché tra un quarto d'ora partiremo per la Germania. I nostri cuori sono spezzati per essere stati costretti ad abbandonarvi in così tenera età". Sulla base delle testimonianze dei parenti sopravvissuti e degli amici di famiglia, e supportato dagli strumenti dello storico, l'autore ricostruisce passo passo la breve esistenza di Matès e Idesa, attraverso archivi pubblici, lettere, foto, racconti di amici e vicini di casa. E grazie anche al prezioso Yizkor-Bukh di Parczew, il "libro della memoria", pubblicato dai sopravvissuti della Seconda guerra mondiale: un volume di storia locale in ebraico e yiddish destinato a far rivivere lo shtetl scomparso. "Credo di essere diventato uno storico per poter fare un giorno una scoperta come questa. La differenza tra le nostre storie familiari e quella che si vorrebbe chiamare la Storia, con la sua pomposa lettera maiuscola, non ha alcun senso. Non ci sono, da una parte, i grandi della terra, con i loro scettri o i loro interventi televisivi e, dall'altra, la risacca della vita quotidiana, le collere e le speranze senza un domani, le lacrime anonime, gli sconosciuti il cui nome arrugginisce sulla base di un monumento ai caduti o in qualche cimitero di campagna. Fare storia equivale a prestare ascolto alle palpitazioni del silenzio."

The Bus Ride - Marianne Dubuc 2015-03-01

?This is the first time I'm taking the bus by myself. Mom packed me a snack --- and had me bring my sweater in case I get cold.? But Mom likely didn't imagine the adventure her little girl would have as she rides to her grandmother's house in this sweet picture book. While the bus is taking her down the streets, through a forest and into a pitch-black tunnel, the little girl encounters an assortment of animal characters who enliven her journey, including a goat who offers her a flower from a bouquet, a wolf child with whom she happily shares her cookies and a fox who attempts to pickpocket a beaver. Adding to the fun are lots of running visual gags, such as the changing headlines on the newspaper that hides one passenger's face, a sleeping sloth who mysteriously appears in different seats without ever having woken up and a nervous-looking turtle whose head and arms pop in and out of its shell. The interior of the bus covers each two-page spread, and award-winning author-illustrator Marianne Dubuc uses subtle colors and tiny details to draw in youngsters to the activity happening there. This book offers a potentially multilayered classroom reading experience: there is the terrific main story of the girl's trip, but there are also any number of mini stories playing out at the same time with each of the other characters. It would work beautifully as a jumping-off point for children to do some imaginary storytelling of their own.

Do What You Want - Bad Religion 2020-08-18

From their beginnings as teenagers experimenting in a San Fernando Valley garage dubbed "The Hell Hole" to headlining major music festivals around the world, discover the whole story of Bad Religion's forty-year career in irreverent style. *Do What You Want*'s principal storytellers are the four voices that define Bad Religion: Greg Graffin, a Wisconsin kid who sang in the choir and became an L.A. punk rock icon while he was still a teenager; Brett Gurewitz, a high school dropout who founded the independent punk label Epitaph Records and went on to become a record mogul; Jay Bentley, a surfer and skater who gained recognition as much for his bass skills as for his antics on and off the stage; and Brian Baker, a founding member of Minor Threat who joined the band in 1994 and brings a fresh perspective as an intimate outsider. With a unique blend of melodic hardcore and thought-provoking lyrics, Bad Religion paved the

way for the punk rock explosion of the 1990s, opening the door for bands like NOFX, The Offspring, Rancid, Green Day, and Blink-182 to reach wider audiences. They showed the world what punk could be, and they continue to spread their message one song, one show, one tour at a time.

Lamberto, Lamberto, Lamberto - Gianni Rodari 2011-12-06

A fable for children and adults: a story of life, death, and terrorism—in the grand tradition of Exupéry's *The Little Prince* When we first meet 93-year-old millionaire Baron Lamberto, he has been diagnosed with 24 life-threatening ailments—one for each of the 24 banks he owns. But when he takes the advice of an Egyptian mystic and hires servants to chant his name over and over again, he seems to not only get better, but younger. Except then a terrorist group lays siege to his island villa, his team of bank managers has to be bussed in to help with the ransom negotiations, and a media spectacle breaks out . . . A hilarious and strangely moving tale that seems ripped from the headlines—although actually written during the time the Red Brigades were terrorizing Italy—Gianni Rodari's *Lamberto, Lamberto, Lamberto* has become one of Italy's most beloved fables. Never before translated into English, the novel is a reminder, as Rodari writes, that "there are things that only happen in fairytales."

Pinocchio, the Tale of a Puppet - Carlo Collodi 2011-02

Pinocchio, The Tale of a Puppet follows the adventures of a talking wooden puppet whose nose grew longer whenever he told a lie and who wanted more than anything else to become a real boy. As carpenter Master Antonio begins to carve a block of pinewood into a leg for his table the log shouts out, "Don't strike me too hard!" Frightened by the talking log, Master Cherry does not know what to do until his neighbor Geppetto drops by looking for a piece of wood to build a marionette. Antonio gives the block to Geppetto. And thus begins the life of Pinocchio, the puppet that turns into a boy. *Pinocchio, The Tale of a Puppet* is a novel for children by Carlo Collodi is about the mischievous adventures of Pinocchio, an animated marionette, and his poor father and woodcarver Geppetto. It is considered a classic of children's literature and has spawned many derivative works of art. But this is not the story we've seen in film but the original version full of harrowing adventures faced by Pinnocchio. It includes 40 illustrations.
