Brown's resulting three-part series in the *Miami Herald* was one of the most explosive news stories of the decade, revealing how Epstein ran a global sex trafficking pyramid scheme with impunity for years, targeting vulnerable teens, often from fractured homes and then turning them into recruiters. The outrage led to Epstein's arrest, the disappearance and eventual arrest of his closest accomplice Ghislaine Maxwell, and the resignation of Acosta. The financier's mysterious suicide in a New York City

jail cell prompted wild speculation about the secrets he took to the grave-and whether his death was intentional or the result of foul play.
