A doll stuffed tightly is bigger than a loosely stuffed doll. For the big ducky I used DK (crocheted 2 strands together) and a 5 mm hook. For the medium sized duckies I used DK (crocheted one strand) and a 4mm hook. For the smallest duckies I used fine cotton (sport, baby) and a 3 mm hook. Size: The duckies and eggs are 3 inches tall (7.5 cm). This pattern uses US Crochet Abbreviations: ch = chain; sc = single crochet (UK : dc = double crochet); st = stitch; sl = slip; rnd = round; tog = together.
