With unprecedented access to personal records, Cristina De Stefano brings to life this remarkable woman whose groundbreaking work and torrid love affairs are not easily forgotten.

The Unmasking of Oriana Fallaci: Part II and Conclusion to Her Life Story brings to an end years of painstaking research. This biography highlights Fallaci's career as a journalist, interviewer, war reporter, essayist, and novelist. Its uniqueness consists less in a chronological listing of events but rather in emphasis on the core of Fallaci's psychological dynamism. This woman from Florence relentlessly placed her embellished persona in the public eye; she thirsted for stardom, allowing nothing to block her ascent to prominence; she essentially functioned as her own publicity agent. Aricò maintains that this same narcissism is present in all of her early Hollywood articles, celebrated

9/11 in European Literature - Svenja Frank 2017-11-28

This volume looks at the representation of 9/11 and the resulting wars in European literature. In the face of inner-European divisions the texts under consideration take the terror attacks as a starting point to negotiate European as well as national identity. While the volume shows that these identity formations are frequently based on the construction of two Others—the US nation and a cultural-ethnic idea of Muslim communities—it also analyses examples which undermine such constructions. This much more self-critical strand in European literature unveils the Eurocentrism of a supposedly general humanistic value system through the use of complex aesthetic strategies. These strategies are in itself characteristic of the European

reception as the Anglo-Irish, British, Dutch, Flemish, French, German, Italian, and Polish perspectives collected in this volume perceive of the terror attacks through the lens of continental media and semiotic theory.

The Force of Reason - Oriana Fallaci

Oriana Fallaci is back with her much-anticipated follow up to *The Rage and the Pride*, her powerful post-September 11 manifesto. The genesis for *The Force of Reason* was a postscript entitled *Due Anni Dopo* (Two Years Later), which was intended as a brief appendix to the thirtieth edition of *The Rage and the Pride* (2002). Once Ms. Fallaci completed the postscript, she chose to expand it into a book, a continuation of her ideas set in motion in *The Rage and the Pride*. In *The Force of Reason* Fallaci takes aim at the many attacks and death threats she received after the publication of *The Rage and the Pride*. Ms. Fallaci begins by identifying herself with one Master Cecco, the author of a heretical book who was burnt at the stake during the Inquisition seven centuries ago on account of his beliefs, and proceeds with a rigorous analysis of the burning of Troy and the creation of a Europe that, to her judgment, is no longer her familiar

homeland but rather a place best called Eurabia, a soon-to-be colony of Islam (with Italy as its stronghold). Ms. Fallaci explores her ideas in historical, philosophical, moral, and political terms, courageously addressing taboo topics with sharp logic.

Saigon e così sia, dal titolo di un famoso articolo di Oriana Fallaci pubblicato da "L'Europeo" nel maggio 1975, raccoglie in un volume postumo i reportage dal Vietnam del Nord e dalla Cambogia (1969-1970), alcune celebri interviste ai protagonisti di quel conflitto e lo straordinario resoconto della caduta di Saigon. Come scrive Ferruccio de Bortoli, "è l'ideale continuazione di Niente e così sia, un diario preciso, un racconto fedele". Alla preparazione di quest'opera la Fallaci si era dedicata a più riprese, spinta dal desiderio di completare la sua testimonianza della guerra nel Sud-Est asiatico: in quegli anni Oriana si fa ricevere dal generale Giap, parla con le giovani donne impegnate nella difesa antiaerea, incontra due prigionieri americani, va in Cambogia e scrive dei Khmer rossi e del

corrotto e astutissimo re Sihanouk. La Fallaci è come sempre in prima linea e il suo giudizio è coraggioso e netto: "Gli elementari diritti delle creature sono infranti sia a Saigon che ad Hanoi, da nessuna parte della barricata v'è la risposta alle nostre speranze".
